**CHARIS** - G5485 χάρις charis (cha'-ris) n.

1. (of manner or act) graciousness (as gratifying). 2. (especially) grace, the divine influence upon the heart, and its reflection in the life. 3. (also) gratitude. 4. (hence) thanks (as gratitude expressed). 5. (as adjective) gracious. 6. (by extension) gracious benevolence. 7. (of politics or manipulation) influential favor, either good or bad (i.e. a storing up acts of kindness toward future repayment; political influence).

**HUPOMONE** - G5281 ὑπομονή hypomone (hī-po-mo-nee') n.

endurance (cheerful or hopeful), constancy.

[from G5278 **hypomeno** v.]

KJV: enduring, patience, patient continuance (waiting)

**HUPOMENO** - G5278 ὑπομένω hypomeno (hī-po-me'-nō) v.

1. to remain under or behind. 2. (figuratively) to endure, to undergo (trials). 3. (by implication) to have fortitude.

KJV: abide, endure, (take) patient(-ly), suffer, tarry behind

**SOZO** - G4982 σώζω sozo (sō'-zō) v.

I. to save, keep safe and sound, to rescue from danger or destruction one (from injury or peril)

A. to save a suffering one (from perishing), i.e. one suffering from disease; 1) to make well, heal, restore to health; 2) to preserve one who is in danger of destruction, to save or rescue

B. to save in the technical biblical sense 1) negatively [a] to deliver from the penalties of the Messianic judgment [b] to save from the evils which obstruct the reception of the Messianic deliverance  
{literally or figuratively}

[from a primary sos (contraction for obsolete saos, "safe")]

KJV: heal, preserve, save (self), do well, be (make) whole

**SOTERIA** - G4991 σωτηρία soteria (sō-tee-riy'-a) n.

I. deliverance, preservation, safety, salvation (a) deliverance from the molestation of enemies (b) in an ethical sense, that which concludes to the souls safety or salvation - of Messianic salvation; II. salvation as the present possession of all true Christian; III. future salvation, the sum of benefits and blessings which the Christians, redeemed from all earthly ills, will enjoy after the visible return of Christ from heaven in the consummated and eternal kingdom of God.

KJV: deliver, health, salvation, save, saving

**PISTIS** - G4102 πίστις pistis (piy'-stis) n.

1. a trust. 2. a firm persuasion, a confidence. 3. (especially) a reliance upon Jesus for salvation. 4. (abstractly) constancy in such reliance. 5. (by extension) the trust in Jesus and the resulting conduct and attitudes of abiding in the Truth Himself.

KJV: assurance, belief, believe, faith, fidelity

# BIBLE VERSES

## John 15:18-20

[ESV] **18** “If the world hates you, know that it has hated me before it hated you. **19** If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you. **20** Remember the word that I said to you: A servant is not greater than his master.’ If they persecuted me, they will also persecute you. If they kept my word, they will also keep yours.

[RCPV] **18** “Kon nasilag kaninyo ang kalibotan, hinumdomi nga akoy unang gikasilagan niini. **19** Kon kamo iya pa sa kalibotan, higugmaon unta kamo sa kalibotan ington nga iya sa kalibotan. ## Romans 5:3

[ESV] Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance (Gk. *hypomone*),

[RCPV] Nagmalipayon usab kita diha sa atong mga pag-antos kay nasayod man kita nga ang mga pag-antos maghimo kanatong malahutayon (Gk. *hypomone*).

## Romans 5:10

[ESV] For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved (Gk. *sozo*) by his life.

[RCPV] Ug kay mga anak man kita niya, madawat nato ang mga panalangin nga gitagana sa Dios ug madawat nato kini uban kang Cristo. Kay kon makig-ambit kita sa iyang mga pag-antos, makaambit usab kita sa iyang himaya.

## Romans 10:13

[ESV] For “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved (Gk. *sozo*).”

[RCPV] Sumala sa Kasulatan, “Ang tanan nga magsangpit sa ngalan sa Ginoo maluwas (Gk. *sozo*).”

## Romans 13:11

[ESV] Besides this you know the time, that the hour has come for you to wake from sleep. For salvation (Gk. *soteria*) is nearer to us now than when we first believed.

[RCPV] Nasayod kamo unsa nang taknaa karon. Mao na kini ang panahon nga angay kamong magmata. Kay mas duol na kanato karon ang kaluwasan (Gk. *soteria*) kay sa pagsugod nato sa pagtuo.

## **Ephesians 2:5**

[ESS] even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ— by grace (Gk. *charis*) you have been saved—

[RCPV] Bisan gani nga kaniadto patay na kita sa espiritu tungod sa atong pagkadaotan, gibanhaw kita niya uban kang Cristo. Naluwas kamo tungod sa grasya (Gk. *charis*) sa Dios.

## **Ephesians 2:8**

[ESV] For by grace (Gk. *charis*) you have been saved through faith (Gk. *pistis*). And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God,

[RCPV] Kay pinaagi sa pagtuo (Gk. *pistis*) naluwas kamo tungod sa grasya (Gk. *charis*) sa Dios. Dili kini inyong buhat kondili gasa sa Dios.

## **Philippians 1:29**

[ESV] For it has been granted to you that for the sake of Christ you should not only believe in him but also suffer for his sake,

[RCPV] Kay gihatagan kamo sa pribilihiyo dili lamang sa pagtuo kang Cristo kondili sa pag-antos usab tungod ug alang kaniya

## **Philippians 3:20-21**

[ESV] **20** But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, **21** who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself.

[ESV] if we endure (Gk. *hypomeno*), we will also reign with him; if we deny him, he also will deny us;

[RCPV] Kon molahutay (Gk. *hypomeno*) kita, maghari usab kita uban kaniya. Kon ilimod ta siya, ilimod usab kita niya.

## **2 Timothy 3:12 (ESV)**

[ESV] Indeed, all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted,

[RCPV] Ang tanan nga nagtinguba sa pagkinabuhi nga diosnon diha kang Cristo Jesus lutoson gayod.

## **Hebrews 10:36 (ESV)**

[ESV] For you have need of endurance (Gk. *hypomone*), so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised.

[RCPV] Kinahanglan nga magmapailubon (Gk. *hypomone*) kamo aron mabuhat ninyo ang kabubut-on sa Dios ug madawat ang iyang gisaad. <inaccurate translation>

[APSD] Kinahanglan nga magmainantuson (Gk. *hypomone*) kamo aron matuman ninyo ang kabubut-on sa Dios ug madawat ninyo ang iyang gisaad.

## **Hebrews 12:1 (ESV)**

[ESV] Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance (Gk. *hypomone*) the race that is set before us,

**[RCPV]** Busa, kay gilibotan man kita niining dakong pundok sa mga saksi, isalikway ta ang tanan nga nakababag kanato ug ang sala nga naghawid kanato pag-ayo. Daganon ta nga matinud-anon (Gk. *hypomone*) ang lumba nga atong gisalmotan. <inaccurate translation>

**[APSD]** Karon, bahin kanato, kita sama sa nagadagan sa lumba nga gilibotan sa daghang mga tawo nga mao ang mga nagpamatuod sa ilang pagtuo sa Dios. Busa biyaan nato ang mga sala nga naghawid kanato, ang tanang nagbabag sa atong pagdagan. Padayonon ta gayod (Gk. *hypomone*) ang atong pagdagan hangtod sa kataposan.

### **Hebrews 11:1**

**[ESV]** Now faith (Gk. *pistis*) is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

**[RCPV]** Ang kahulogan sa pagtuo (Gk. *pistis*) mao nga may kasigurohan kita sa mga butang nga atong gilaoman nga dili makita.

### **Hebrews 12:7**

**[ESV]** It is for discipline that you have to endure (Gk. *hypomeno*). God is treating you as sons. For what son is there whom his father does not discipline?

**[RCPV]** Lahutay (Gk. *hypomeno*) sa inyong giantos ingon nga pagdisiplina kaninyo. Ang pagdisiplina kaninyo nagpaila nga giisip kamo sa Dios nga iyang mga anak. Kay may anak ba gud nga dili disiplinahan sa iyang amahan?

### **James 1:3 (ESV)**

**[ESV]** for you know that the testing of your faith (Gk. *pistis*) produces steadfastness (Gk. *hypomone*).

**[RCPV]** kay nasayod kamo nga ang inyong pagtuo (Gk. *pistis*) gisulayan lamang aron kamo mahimong malahutayon (Gk. *hypomone*).

### **James 1:12**

**[ESV]** Blessed is the man who remains steadfast (Gk. *hypomeno*) under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him.

**[RCPV]** Bulahan ang tawo nga mobarog (Gk. *hypomeno*) taliwala sa mga pagtintal kay sa iyang pagdaog makadawat siya sa kinabuhi, ang ganti nga gisaad sa Dios alang niadtong mga nahugma kaniya.

### **James 2:20**

**[ESV]** Do you want to be shown, you foolish person, that faith (Gk. *pistis*) apart from works is useless?

**[RCPV]** Buangbuang! Kinahanglan ka pa bang saysayan nga ang pagtuo (Gk. *pistis*) nga dili ubanag mga buhat walay kapuslanan?

### **James 2:24**

**[ESV]** You see that a person is justified by works and not by faith (Gk. *pistis*) alone.

**[RCPV]** Busa nakita ninyo nga ang usa ka tawo isipon sa Dios nga matarong tungod sa iyang mga buhat, ug dili tungod sa pagtuo (Gk. *pistis*) lamang.

### **James 2:26**

**[ESV]** For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, so also faith (Gk. *pistis*) apart from works is dead.

**[RCPV]** Kay sama nga patay ang lawas nga wala nay espiritu, patay usab ang pagtuo (Gk. *pistis*) kon walay mga buhat.

## **1 Peter 1:5**

[ESV] who by God's power are being guarded through faith (Gk. *pistis*) for a salvation (Gk. *soteria*) ready to be revealed in the last time.

[RCPV] Pinaagi sa pagtuo (Gk. *pistis*) gipanalipdan kamo sa gahom sa Dios alang sa kaluwasan (Gk. *soteria*) nga andam nang ipadayag sa kataposan nga panahon.

## **1 Peter 1:7**

[ESV] so that the tested genuineness of your faith (Gk. *pistis*) — more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

[RCPV] Ang tuyo niini mao ang pagsulay kon tinoed ba gayod ang inyong pagtuo (Gk. *pistis*) kay bisan gani ang bulawan nga lumalabay lamang sulayan man pinaagi sa kalayo. Ang inyong pagtuo (Gk. *pistis*) nga bililhon pa kay sa bulawan sulayan gayod usab. Tungod niini madawat ninyo ang mga pagdayeg, himaya ug dungog sa Adlaw nga ipadayag na si Jesu-Cristo.

## **1 John 5:4 (ESV)**

[ESV] For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith (Gk. *pistis*).

[RCPV] Kay ang tanang anak sa Dios makabuntog sa kalibutan ug gidaog nato ang kalibutan pinaagi sa atong pagtuo (Gk. *pistis*).

## **1 John 5:19**

[ESV] We know that we are from God, and the whole world lies in the power of the evil one.

[RCPV] Nasayod kita nga iya kita sa Dios ug ang tibuok kalibutan naulipon sa Yawa.

## **Revelation 14:12**

[ESV] Here is a call for the endurance (Gk. *hypomone*) of the saints, those who keep the commandments of God and their faith in Jesus.

[RCPV] Kinahanglan nga molahutay (Gk. *hypomone*) ang katawhan sa Dios, sila nga nagtuman sa mga sugo sa Dios ug nagmaminatud-on kang Jesus.
